## BIBLICAL REFLECTION | What Does God Say About This?

- 4) Read 1 John 2:1-2. Raise your hand if you sinned again after you surrendered to Christ? So, since that's all of us, how does this verse change your thought about Christ's sacrifice's continued work in our lives?
